(Stocks, Bonds, Mutual Funds, Etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Check on Company Benefits (Employer)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Call Attorney as Needed
- \_\_\_\_\_ Check on Status of Creditors
- \_\_\_\_\_ Make any Changes on Real Estate as Needed
- \_\_\_\_\_ Make a List for Acknowledgement Cards and Mail
- \_\_\_\_\_ Plan to Attend Grief/Recovery Workshops
- \_\_\_\_\_ Mail Death Notices or Personal Cards to Friends Out of the Area
